

Morrison Academy Kaohsiung is the southern campus of Morrison Academy. Morrison Academy operates three high schools (grades 9-12) and four elementary and middle schools with a system-wide enrollment of 952. Morrison Academy was founded in 1952 to meet the educational needs of the children of missionaries throughout Taiwan. Morrison seeks to develop a Christ-centered school culture in which all students from missionary and non-missionary families experience a Biblically- integrated quality education. The vision for our learners guides students to develop the knowledge, discernment, and abilities to dynamically impact their world in a positive way.

STUDENT BODY & FACULTY

Kaohsiung's high school enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year is 82, with students from 15 countries, predominantly the U.S. and Canada. Of the 23 members of the class of 2024, these nations are represented: Canada, Hong Kong, Ireland, South Korea, United Kingdom, and the United States. There are 19 students in the junior class, 23 in the sophomore class, and 17 in the freshman class. Our high school faculty are all certified and several have advanced degrees.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Morrison Academy offers a wide range of activities to develop student interests and abilities. Visual and performing arts programs include band, orchestra, as well as various fine arts classes. Athletically, students have the opportunity to participate in soccer, basketball, swimming, track, cross country, and volleyball. Morrison students also have the opportunity to participate in student government, clubs, robotics, and a range of outreach, community service, and leadership development programs.
